



Notes to Audience and Participants

Tempo Festival of the Arts

We thank you for your cooperation.

All entrants in music classes must hand an original of their piece to the secretary of the session in which they are playing before the session begins

No practicing in the festival hall in the thirty minutes prior to the session.

Performers must provide their own accompanist. A chord may be given on the piano at the beginning of an unaccompanied selection. Only dance classes may use taped music.

The executive has the right to alter the order of the program in order to accommodate unforeseen circumstances.

In the event of a withdrawal, there will be no refund of the entry fee. If unable to perform, the entrant is asked to contact the emcee or secretary as soon as possible. Please contact Brenda for any questions of cancellation.

We would request that performers arrive at least 15 minutes before the session begins and that they remain in the festival hall until their class is over.

Audience Etiquette

We respectfully request that audience members maintain a quiet atmosphere.

Enter or leave the festival venue only between performances or after the adjudicator has completed comments.

There is a pause in proceedings while the adjudicator is writing and a shorter space of time immediately after adjudication. At those times it would be appropriate to come and go.

NO PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEO OR AUDIO RECORDING WILL BE ALLOWED DURING THE <u>ADJUDICATOR'S COMMENTS</u>. It is never appropriate to discuss grievances with the adjudicator. Please feel free to contact a festival committee member. Your comments are valuable and will be taken with great respect. All decisions of the adjudicator shall be final.

Any complaints or protests should be made in writing and given to the secretary by May 1st, 2017

Under no circumstances should a complaint or protest be made directly to the adjudicator.

Bursary Info

Tempo Festival of the Arts will be offering a bursary of \$150.00 to one lucky festival participant. This bursary is to be used to support the successful candidate's attendance at a summer school of fine arts in their chosen fields of study. Receipts must be provided to the Tempo Treasurer for reimbursement.

- Recipients do not have to be present at the highlights concert.
- Bursaries are not to be used for lessons.
- Participants are not eligible if they have already won a Tempo Bursary.

It is our belief that every participant in the festival would benefit from such an experience. So, in keeping with the non-competitive nature of the Tempo Festival of the Arts, qualifying candidates will be selected at random from amongst the candidates.

To qualify, candidates must:

- Have participated in the Tempo Festival for at least two years in any discipline.
- Meet all criteria set out by their chosen school for their chosen program
- Complete an application INCLUDING A DETAILED PLAN OF HOW YOU WILL USE THE BURSARY

Submit the application to the festival committee by April 19, 2017 Successful Candidates will be announced at the Highlights Concert.

Speech Arts - Brenda Gorlick



Brenda has been involved in the Performing Arts world for nearly 40 years in many aspects of the business. As a performer, she has acted, sang and danced her way across Canada, the U.S. and parts of Europe including Canada's Royal Winnipeg Ballet, the acclaimed Stratford Festival and the Banff Centre of Fine Arts. She received a Women of Distinction Award for Arts and Culture in 2015 and was named to the Wall of Fame at Rainbow Stage in 2014.

Brenda serves as Associate Artistic director for Winnipeg Studio Theatre – a cutting edge professional musical theatre company which has produced hit shows such as Spring Awakening, Altar Boyz and the world premiere of Hersteria! She helms the youth and adult StudioWorks program – a training wing for emerging artists who wish to excel in "triple threat" technique. The troupes have performed at numerous events including Winnipeg Fringe Festival, Words and Deeds Gala, WSO's Adventures in Music series and DisneyWorld's Magic Music Days.

Ms. Gorlick has appeared as Morticia in Dry Cold Production's hit – The Addams Family and appeared in both Rainbow Stage productions: the epic Les Misérables and hysterical Sister Act. Selected performer credits include: MTC/Theatre Calgary's co-production of Evita, Rainbow Stage's Wizard of Oz in the coveted role of Wicked Witch of the West, Jennyanydots/Gumbie in Cats and the ultimate role of Anita in the Banff Centre's West Side Story. In film, Ms. Gorlick portrayed the principal role of Phyllis Flatow opposite Shirley Maclaine in the movie of the week, Hell On Heels: The Mary Kay Project. She acted as Assistant Dance Crew Liaison for Miramax Productions feature flick: Shall We Dance starring Richard Gere and Jennifer Lopez , and choreographed one episode of Murdoch Mysteries.

She has been involved in over 250 productions including every theatre in Winnipeg over the past 35 years.

As an Artist in the Schools, Brenda has created projects throughout the province for over 20 years. She also serves as resident choreographer/instructor for the Society of Manitobans with Disabilities and

the Manitoba rep. for the DTRC (Dancer Transition Resource Centre). Brenda is a guest professor in dance and musical theatre for the Universities of Winnipeg and Manitoba and a regular mentor for the ACI Manitoba Mentorship program.

He is a company member with Winnipeg's Contemporary Dancers and this summer he will appear in Mamma Mia, his third musical with Rainbow Stage. His own choreography has been presented in Vancouver at Dancing On The Edge and in Winnipeg at the Fringe and ReelPride festivals. The Tempo Festival was the first time Brett performed in front of an adjudicator and he is so excited to be back adjudicating for the first time!

Our Adjudicators are a vital part of the Tempo Festival. They are amongst the best that Manitoba can offer in her area of expertise. Finding and hiring an adjudicator begins in June of the previous year due to the demands of teaching and festival work.

Piano – Everett Hoepfner



Canadian pianist Everett Hopfner is a proud native of Ste. Rose du Lac, Manitoba, celebrated for his passionate and inventive performances of contemporary music. His repertoire encompasses dynamic new Canadian pieces for solo piano and established masterworks of the European avant-garde.

From interactive Fluxus installations to spirited "one-man shows" incorporating electronic media, improvisation, movement and speech, Everett channels his diverse talents and creative interests into unique, multi-disciplinary performances. His love for collaboration and communication leads Everett frequently to chamber music and larger ensemble settings.

Everett manages an international profile: he has toured across Canada as a winner of the Eckhardt-Gramatté National Music Competition and throughout Germany as a keyboardist of the Junge Deutsche Philharmonie. His playing has been broadcast on numerous occasions by Hessischer Rundfunk and CBC Radio. Everett is a longtime participant at Casalmaggiore International Festival in Italy and has performed in Stuttgart's *Lachenmann Perspektiven*, ZKM Karlsruhe's *piano+ Festival*, Trinity Laban Conservatoire's *CoLab*.

As an educator, Everett maintains a teaching studio at the Eckhardt-Gramatté Conservatory of Music and is a sessional instructor for piano and collaborative piano at Brandon University. He enjoys sharing his enthusiasm, imagination and constructive pedagogical approach with musicians of all levels in workshops and masterclasses. Everett's dedication to his artistic community is reflected in his podcast, "ALL EARS," a series of interviews with musical friends, colleagues and mentors.

Everett Hopfner holds degrees from Brandon University (B. Mus.), Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst Frankfurt am Main (Dipl. Mus.) and Musikhochschule Stuttgart (M. Mus.). His principal teachers are Megumi Masaki, Catherine Vickers and Nicolas Hodges. Everett is grateful for career assistance from the Manitoba Arts Council and from numerous friends and supporters


